
## CoEL Annual Summary - 2016/17




We directly supported 994 carers in the year and were in contact with 2488 carers by the end of the year. Since 2013 our funding has reduced by 36% while the number of carers we have on our database has increased by 76%!




↔ We generated £626,263 in annual increased welfare benefits for 180 different people.

✤ 93% described staff knowledge as Very Good – the remaining 7% said we were good. 100% said we were easy to get in touch with. These figures are better than previous years.



✤ We gave out grants totalling £15,238 enabling 77 carers to get a break and helped carers get an addition £3,150 in grants.

We referred people to 135 different organisations over the year – everything from Al Anon to Venture Scotland.



✤ 84% of carers said they felt better able to cope as a result of our support

- We ran 7 support groups attended by 135 different carers over the year.
- We also arranged 11 workshops for carers everything from Taking Care of Yourself with Yoga to Managing Challenging Behaviours!
- We supported 50 Carers with Powers of Attorney
